Dear Mr. Gable:

We are hereby respectfully requesting an Encroachment Agreement be granted for an 18" SDR 26 Storm Sewer and endwall to be installed within the Right of Way of Chartiers Avenue at its intersection with Sycamore Street and to the tributary stream of Chartiers Creek. This is all situate in the 28th Ward of the City of Pittsburgh.

Under the Grow Grant initiative, Crafton Borough is planning to construct this sewer to separate sewage in this presently combined area. The project will include the installation of the new storm sewer, disconnecting and capping the connection to the 24" combination sewer on the Crafton side of Chartiers Avenue, restoration of the roadway and ground, and building a concrete endwall with riprap that outfalls near an UNT to Chartiers Creek (WWF). A Chapter 105 GP-4 (General Permit for the stormwater outfall into the Stream) is being requested. This will have little to no impact on the stream and will decrease the amount of stormwater entering the ALCOSAN system and treatment plant.

18" STORM SEWER, MANHOLE, AND ENDWALL ENCROACHMENT WITHIN PUBLIC RIGHT OF WAY

All that certain encroachment, variable width, situate in the 28th Ward, City of Pittsburgh, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania, being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the southerly right of way line of Chartiers Avenue, 50 feet wide at this point, at the northeast corner of lands now or formerly of Cellone Bakery, Inc.; thence from said point of beginning through Chartiers Avenue N 38° 30′ W a distance of 27.0 feet, more or less, to a point on the municipal line dividing Crafton Borough and the 28th Ward, City of Pittsburgh; thence by the municipal line dividing Crafton Borough and the 28th Ward, City of Pittsburgh N 73° 49′ E a distance of 16.2 feet, more or less, to a point; thence through Chartiers Avenue S 38° 30′ E a distance of 48.7 feet, more or less, to a point in an unnamed tributary to Chartiers Creek; thence continuing through Chartiers Avenue and through the unnamed tributary to Chartiers Creek S 63° 18′ W a distance of 27.3 feet to a point on the westerly right of way line of Chartiers Avenue, being the easterly line of lands now or formerly of Cellone Bakery, Inc.; thence by the westerly right of way line of Chartiers Avenue, being the easterly line of lands now or formerly of Cellone Bakery, Inc., N 10° 49′ W a distance of 25.2 feet, more or less, to a point on the southerly right of way line of Chartiers Avenue at the northeast corner of lands now or formerly of Cellone Bakery, Inc., at the point of beginning.

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
