Enclosed for your consideration is a proposed Resolution authorizing the Pittsburgh Land Bank to acquire all the City's right, title and interest, if any, in and to the following publicly owned properties, and to incur all necessary and incidental expenses relating to said acquisition:

The above parcels contain a total of approximately 2,117 square feet. The Pittsburgh Land Bank would like to acquire these properties for conveyance to the Rising Tide Partners for a stabilization pilot in conformance with the adopted neighborhood plan. Rising Tide currently owns two row houses attached to 201 and 205 Glen Caladh Street. This project aligns with the priority to develop a strategy to address vacant properties and is in partnership with the Registered Community Organization (RCO).
