Attached is a proposed Resolution authorizing the Mayor and Director of the Department of Public Works to execute relevant agreements to receive grant funding in the amount of SIX HUNDRED AND FIFTY THOUSAND (\$650,000) from the Recycling Partnership for the purpose of conducting public outreach surrounding the City's recycling program and purchasing and distributing containers for curbside residential recycling collection.
