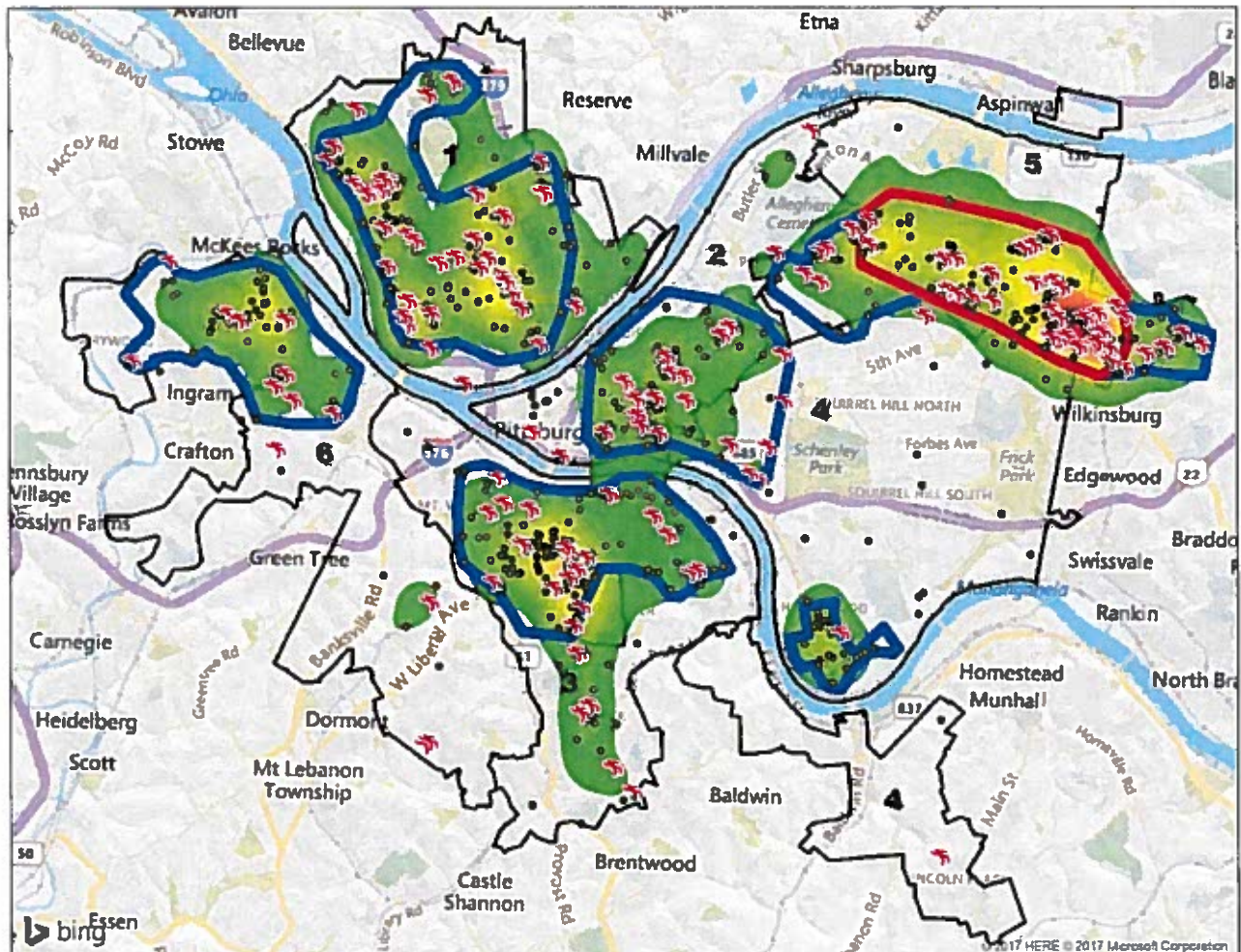

## ShotSpotter Expansion

- The current ShotSpotter deployment in Zone 5 is 3.0 square miles.
- Proposed ShotSpotter additions would be a 15.0 square mile addition:
  - Zone 1 – 4.5 square miles
  - Zone 2/4 – 3.0 square miles
  - Zone 3 – 3.1 square miles
  - Zone 4 - .4 square miles
  - Zone 5 – 1.5 square mile addition
  - Zone 6 – 2.5 square miles
- After expansion, 18.0 square miles represent 80.5% of “Shots Fired” calls and 87.5% of Gun-Related Homicides using statistics from January 1<sup>st</sup> 2015 through December 15<sup>th</sup> 2017.



**Deployment Plan:**

- Zone 1 – 4.5 square miles
- Zone 3 – 3.1 square miles
- Zone 2/4 – 3.0 square miles
- Zone 5 – 1.5 square mile addition
- Zone 6 – 2.5 square miles
- Zone 4 - .4 square miles

**ShotSpotter Data:**

- Since its inception in 2015, 5,889 SST indications pointed to 2,278 shots fired incidents.
  - 83 gunshot victims have been located.
  - 48 arrests have been made in incidents where officers responded to a shot spotter call.
