Please be advised that the Allegheny County Law Department has approved the following question for placement upon the May 19, 2026, General Primary ballot. Following past practice, the Law Department finds that the form of the petition and its timely filing make the petition presumptively proper for placement on the ballot.

“ Shall the City of Pittsburgh Home Rule Charter, Article Three, Legislative Branch, be amended by changing public hearing notice requirements to adjust for public hearing notice requirements in light of changes in the public consumption of newspapers of general circulation and increased use of digital media?”

Note that the “Plain English Statement” as required by the Pennsylvania Election Code will be developed by this Division and will be forthcoming.
