Bill No. [2008-0844](#) Ordinance Amending the Pittsburgh Code of Ordinances, Title Six: Conduct; Article I: Regulated Rights and Actions; Chapter 601: Public Order; Section 601.08: Alcohol or Liquor Consumption on Streets or Sidewalks, by increasing the fine for an initial offense from \$50 to \$200, by increasing the fine for a second offense from \$100 to \$300, and by deleting the requirement that repeat offenses occur within one year.
