- **Leadership** I have been providing leadership to people who ride bikes and walk in Allegheny County by ensuring we have a seat at the table with local elected officials, directors of public agencies, and with community leaders undertaking community-led planning initiatives. I have sat on the steering committees for dozens of community plans including the City of Pittsburgh Bike(+) Plan, Uptown Eco Innovation Plan, East Liberty Mobility Plan, Bus Rapid Transit Steering Committee, Active Allegheny Mobility Plan, and the PA Strategic Hwy Safety Plan.
- **Entrepreneurship** I served as a key member of the team that brought bike share to Pittsburgh. This multimillion-dollar project is transforming how Pittsburghers get around the city. My role primarily focused on planning, fundraising, best practices, hiring, and relationship building.
- Vision I was one of five people who cofounded BikePGH and took it from just an
 idea to a leadership role in the community and around the country. I have years of
 experience with branding, direction setting, and changemaking that has engaged
 our board, staff and the community resulting in the transformation of Pittsburgh's
 streets.
- **Results** Our advocacy under my direction has resulted in over 100 miles of bikeways designed for our city's streets, Complete Streets policies in multiple municipalities, thousands of bike racks in our sidewalks, parks and buildings, the creation of the first bike map published in Pittsburgh in 15 years, one of the country's most progressive bike parking ordinances, a robust membership program, innovative educational publications, events that attract tens of thousands of participants (OpenStreetsPGH and PedalPGH), hundreds of media mentions, the Bronze Bicycle Friendly Communities award for the City of Pittsburgh, and Pittsburgh being named a top 20 bike city in the U.S. by People For Bikes.
- Management Under my leadership as Executive Director we have grown from a
 one and a half FTE staff with a budget of \$60,000 for a single year to a sustainable
 organization with 12 FTE staff, 25+ part time staff, consultants and interns and a
 budget of over \$1,700,000 for FY 2023. I have experience leading planning efforts,
 facilitating meetings, conducting performance reviews, working with legal counsel,
 managing consultants, and volunteers.
- **Fundraising** I have written and reported on more than \$5,000,000 in grants during my tenure at BikePGH. I also have experience organizing and hosting fundraiser events. I led the acquisition of PedalPGH which now raises more than \$100,000 for our mission every year. Under my direction we have developed multiple earned-income revenue streams from selling bike racks to providing a bike valet service for events. I also have years of experience raising funds from individual donors and corporate sponsors.
- **Relationships** I have developed friendly and professional relationships with my board, dozens of community groups, corporate sponsors and funders. I have helped build coalitions in order to promote active mobility and safe streets.
- **Communications** While I have been executive director, BikePGH has amplified the voice of people who need and who want to get around through active transportation. I have done this by working closely with media contacts, overseeing

the production of our own content for our blog, Instagram, Facebook and Twitter; and hiring a Communications Manager to take our comms to the next level. I have experience writing press releases, press relations, media interviews, and public speaking. BikePGH has grown its following to more than 20,000 email subscribers and 50,000 on social media.
