RE: URA ROW Dedication

Dear Members of City Council:

Enclosed is a proposed Resolution authorizing the City of Pittsburgh to accept the dedication of 35 parcels to the public right of way in the 1st, 3rd, 7th, 8th, 11th, 12th, 13th, 21st, and 22nd Wards (Council Districts 1, 6, 7, 8 & 9) at no cost to the City.

The Urban Redevelopment Authority of Pittsburgh ("URA") has consulted with our staff to identify URA owned parcels which currently function as public right-of-way. DOMI is the City of Pittsburgh Department responsible for the transportation of people and goods throughout the City, and manages the operation of and access to the public right-of-way. The URA is the City of Pittsburgh's economic development enterprise. Given this misalignment in ownership and mission, we kindly request that the City accept the dedication of these parcels.

Where possible, the URA has provided DOMI with legal descriptions, site surveys and plans, as well as as-built drawings and inspection reports. Further, the URA has committed to providing any additional records for these parcels, if they find any.

Your favorable consideration of the attached proposed Resolution is hereby requested.
