Dear President and Members:

Attached is a proposed Resolution for the designation as a City Historic Structure the Mowry-Addison House, located at 5134 Carnegie Street, in the Lawrenceville Neighborhood, in the 10th Ward, City of Pittsburgh.

In accordance with Historic Preservation Ordinance, the Historic Review Commission and the City Planning Commission have reviewed the nomination of the Mowry-Addison house as a Historic Structure. Both the Historic Review Commission and the City Planning Commission voted to recommend that City Council designate the Mowry-Addison House so that it may be protected and preserved.

The Historic Preservation Ordinance calls for Council to hold a public hearing on the nomination within one-hundred and twenty days (120) days of the Planning Commission's recommendation (July 8, 2020), and then to vote on the designation within one-hundred and twenty (120) days of receipt of these recommendations.
