WHEREAS, The City of Pittsburgh desires to achieve more residential recycling education, produce less contamination, move away from a bag based collection program, provide residential recycling bins, and implement a broader education plan to modernize the City's recycling program;

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Environmental Services issued a Sole Source Contract and Scope of Work for these services and;

WHEREAS, this contracted service will provide the City with residential recycling education, online webinars, outreach brochures, and allow the City to continue to grow its residential recycling program, which is in transition from becoming bag free;
