

FIRST AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITIES FOR FINANCIAL EMPOWERMENT FUND and THE CITY OF PITTSBURGH

This First Grant Amendment (the "First Amendment"), dated as of July 11, 2022 (the "First Amendment Effective Date"), is by and between the Cities for Financial Empowerment Fund (the "CFE Fund") and the City of Pittsburgh (the "Grantee") and reflects that the CFE Fund is amending the vendors section of the Summer Jobs Connect Grant Agreement (the "Agreement"). The Agreement, with the Effective Date of March 1, 2022, between the Parties is hereby amended in the following respects:

1. In the section titled "4. Vendor(s).", subsection (a) shall be amended to instead state:

"The Grantee shall contract with Partner4Work and Neighborhood Allies as vendors for the 2022 SYEP program year. The Grantee shall contract with Partner4Work and Youth Enrichment Services as vendors for the 2023 SYEP program year. A Vendor shall be defined for purposes of this Agreement as a community-based 501(c)(3) organization, governmental organization or private entity engaged by the Grantee to support the implementation of the Program (each a "Vendor"). Each Vendor may rely upon the direction and instruction of the Grantee."

All other provisions of Section 4 shall remain unchanged.

2. In <u>Exhibit C</u> ("<u>Budget</u>"), an additional section shall be added as below to reflect the Grantee's budget for their 2023 SYEP program year.

"The Grantee spent \$14,000 of the initial \$20,000 disbursement towards their 2022 SYEP program year and has budgeted the remaining \$56,000 as follows:

- 4. <u>Ratification of the Agreement</u>. As amended by this First Amendment, the Agreement is in all respects ratified and confirmed, and the Agreement, as so amended by this First Amendment, shall be read, taken and construed as one and the same instrument.
- 5. Severability. If any one or more of the covenants, agreements, provisions or terms or portions thereof of this First Amendment shall be for any reason whatsoever held invalid, then such covenants, agreements, provisions or terms or portions thereof shall be deemed severable from the remaining covenants, agreements, provisions, or terms of this First Amendment and shall in no way affect the validity or enforceability of the other covenants, agreements, provisions or terms or portions of this First Amendment.
- 6. <u>Counterparts</u>. This First Amendment may be executed in any number of counterparts, each of which when so executed shall be deemed to be an original and all of which when taken together shall constitute one and the same agreement. Delivery of an executed counterpart of a signature page to this First Amendment by electronic mail in a ".pdf" file shall be effective as delivery of a manually executed counterpart of this First Amendment.

All other terms and conditions of the Agreement that are not hereby amended are to remain in full force and effect.
