Dear President and Members:

Attached is a proposed Resolution for the designation as a City Historic Site, The Tito House located at 1817 Main Street and 1818 Colwell Street (11-E-93 and 11-E-91), in Uptown, in the 3rd Ward, City of Pittsburgh.

In accordance with Historic Preservation Ordinance, the Historic Review Commission and the City Planning Commission have reviewed the nomination of The Tito House as a Historic Site. The Historic Review Commission voted to provide a negative recommendation to City Council. The City Planning Commission voted to recommend that City Council designate Tito House as historic so that it may be protected and preserved.

The Historic Preservation Ordinance calls for Council to hold a public hearing on the nomination within one-hundred and twenty days (120) days of the Planning Commission's recommendation (June 8 2022), and then to vote on the designation within one-hundred and twenty (120) days of receipt of these recommendations.
