Carnegie Mellon University (CMU) formally commits to the financial and project scope of the Safe Streets for All program 2024 (phase 2), as awarded by the United States Department of Transportation. Furthermore, CMU will provide the city with timely advance notice of any issues that could impact the city's ability to complete the grant as outlined in the application. CMU also affirms that the federal contribution to this CMU-initiated and led project will not exceed \$200,000.
