Resolution providing for an Agreement of Agreements and a lease or Leases by and between the City of Pittsburgh ("City") and First Vehicle Services ("First Vehicle") pursuant to which First Vehicle will furnish all work and services needed to manage

and maintain the City's Fleet

Pursuant to the discussion of the above mentioned bill during City Council's Standing Committee meeting held on September 8, 2010; attached please find the following documents pertaining to information as requested during said meeting:

- Copy of contract language excerpts dealing with the following issues as provided by the Law Department:
 - a) Availability of access to Fleet FMIS system
 - b) Quality assurance program flexibility

 - d) Obligation for payment of utilities including water
- Listing of City facilities both metered and non-metered locations as provided by the Pittsburgh Water Authority (PWSA). Please note that the PWSA is currently in the process of updating this information.

• General. The Contractor will own, install, implement and maintain all hardware and software necessary for an electronic record-keeping and reporting system for all services being contracted. The Contractor shall be responsible for all support and maintenance of that system. The information system shall provide records of all repairs and servicing activities performed for each vehicle or piece of equipment.

The Contractor's Fleet Management Information System (FMIS) shall be a multi-user system capable of integrating all information pertaining to inventory, maintenance, repair, personnel, asset management, etc. The Contractor shall allow, upon availability of the system, the Director of Finance or his/her designee(s) and the City Fleet Contract Manager or Staff total, unlimited access to the information system. A City Council designee, (i.e. City Council Budget Director) shall have read only access to the FMIS and the data contained therein. Fleet user departments and/or other authorized City personnel, as approved by the Director of Finance, shall also have read-only access to the FMIS and the data contained therein. Contractor will also provide appropriate training as needed at no cost to the City.

- Quality Assurance Program. The Contractor agrees to implement a Quality Assurance Program for the management of the repair and maintenance of assigned vehicles. The program will include provisions for meeting specified performance standards, for maintaining quality workmanship, for providing a high level of customer service, and for reducing fleet costs incurred by the City. The Contractor further agrees to work with the City to effectuate any necessary changes to said Quality Assurance Program. The plan will address, at a minimum, the following items:
 - Fleet Availability
 - PM Performance
 - Repair Performance
 - Parts Availability
 - Vehicle Safety and Reliability
 - Customer Service
 - Cost Reduction Initiatives

A mandatory component of the Quality Assurance Program is user surveys. Two types will be required: (1) a survey of individual vehicle operator satisfaction each time a vehicle has been serviced, and (2) an annual customer satisfaction survey of designated representatives of each user department. Each User Survey will be available in Contractor furnished and provided custom pamphlet or electronic e-mail Forms.

• Investigations and Audits. As part of its Target Service the Contractor will support the City with technical investigations and failure analyses related to the Fleet. Such investigations may involve accidents, fires, or other issues of a technical nature. The City also reserves the right to obtain third party audits. The authorized representatives of the City, and/or its agents, shall have access, at all reasonable times and upon prior notice to the Contractor's General Manager, to all of the Contractor's receipts and invoices pertaining to work under the Contract, for the purpose of auditing and verifying

costs of work. The City, and/or its agents, will be granted access to such records at all reasonable times during the Agreement period. The City recognizes that the Contractor may consider certain information to be privileged; the City will work with Contractor to safeguard such claimed privileged information.

• <u>Utilities.</u> The Contractor will be responsible for paying for heat, water and electricity billed to the City for the Maintenance Facilities. Contractor will pay its proportionate share of water as determined by the Pittsburgh Water & Sewer Authority.
