Re: Crawford-Roberts – Former Letsche Elementary School Building Authorization of Disposition Contract Council District No. 6

Dear President and Members:

Enclosed for your consideration is a proposed Resolution approving execution of a Contract for Disposition by Sale of Land between the Urban Redevelopment Authority of Pittsburgh and Letsche LLC, or a related entity, for the sale of Block 9-R, Lots 163, 164, 165, and 166, in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Ward of the City of Pittsburgh.

The above lots total approximately 4,956 square feet, with a purchase price of \$30,000 plus costs. The Letsche School project, named after the former Letsche Elementary School in the Hill District's Crawford-Roberts neighborhood, is a redevelopment that repurposes the former school into a 42-unit mixed-income apartment building with accompanying community space as well as the construction of four (4) new townhomes on the adjacent vacant parcels that are the subject of this disposition contract.
