EASEMENT DESCRIPTION

Commencing at a $\frac{3}{4}$ " iron pin being the southwest corner of a parcel of land now or formerly owned by Duquesne Light Company, being recorded in Deed Book 17229, Page 588 in the Allegheny County Department of Real Estate; thence North 87°48′00" West, along the northerly line of Joncaire Street (50') and the southerly line of an existing easement granted to Duquesne Light by the City of Pittsburgh, a distance of \pm 11.8' feet to the **Point of Beginning** of this easement; thence along the northerly line of Joncaire Street, North 87°48′00" West, a distance of \pm 627.5'; thence departing from the northerly line of Joncaire Street and along the lines now or formerly owned by the City of Pittsburgh, North 16°37'37" West, a distance of \pm 15.8'; thence through said property now or formerly owned by the City Of Pittsburgh, South 87°48′00" East, a distance of \pm 612.9' to a point on an existing easement granted to Duquesne Light by the City of Pittsburgh; thence South 34°34′10" West, a distance of \pm 17.8', extending to the said northerly line of Joncaire Street (50') and the line terminus of this easement.
