Dear Council President Kail-Smith:

The Pittsburgh Water and Sewer Authority (PWSA) has reviewed the proposed plans (with PWSA revisions dated 6/22/2020) and supporting documentation for a new separated storm sewer and outfall into Bell's Run to be built by the Borough of Crafton at Sycamore Street and Chartiers Avenue. This project will encroach on City of Pittsburgh property from the centerline of Chartiers Avenue to Bells Run.

PWSA does not have any concerns at this time with respect to the design or location of this project and is generally in support of projects that address the separation of storm and sanitary flows. The PWSA will want to inspect the project during construction to verify and ensure it is being built as designed and that it meets all PWSA standards for construction of storm sewer infrastructure.
