



The following objectives have been identified for the Institutional Master Plan:


- Enhance access to an array of health care services provided at West Penn Hospital within the Allegheny Health Network.



Ten Year Proposed Development Envelope






Parking Structure Medical Office/Clinic Expanded Utility Plant Hospital - Inpatient Care

Twenty-Five Year Development Envelope





• 4 additional stories • 5 total stories • Approx. 60,000 GSF added • Approx.165,000 GSF total • Height of Addition – 75' max.


