Enclosed for your consideration is a proposed Resolution authorizing the Urban Redevelopment Authority of Pittsburgh to acquire all the City's right, title and interest, if any, in and to the following publicly owned properties, and to incur all necessary and incidental expenses relating to said acquisition:

The above parcels contain a total of approximately 13,273 square feet of vacant land. The Allegheny Land Trust has worked with the Perry Hilltop Citizens Council and Fineview Citizens Council on a plan to develop these parcels into community greenspace, to be known as the Unity Trail, that will be connected to the Unity Corner project that Perry Hilltop Citizens Council owns immediately to the north. The URA would like to acquire the property for conveyance to Allegheny Land Trust for development and preservation of this community asset.
