Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Pittsburgh as follows:

Section 1. Amending Ordinance #7 effective March 28, 2002 entitled "An Ordinance supplementing the Pittsburgh Code, Title Seven: Business Licensing, Article VII: Services Businesses, Chapter 763: Parking Lots, Section 763.12. Nonconsensual towing of vehicles from nonresidential parking places." By deleting item (e) to make a clerical correction.

(e) Nonconsensual towing of vehicles from nonresidential parking places under this Section 763.12 shall only be permitted on Mondays through Fridays that are not holidays observed by the City of Pittsburgh and only between the hours of 6 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.
