WHEREAS, Pittsburgh Colfax K-8 is a neighborhood school in the heart of Squirrel Hill, serving students living in parts of Squirrel Hill, East Hills, Homewood, Shadyside and Point Breeze. Its mission is to provide an enriching educational experience to prepare the students to achieve academic excellence and strength of character so they have the opportunity to succeed in all aspects of life. It provides a comprehensive academic core program as well as a being an on-site gifted model school, 3-8 partial immersion Spanish language program and English as a Second Language Center; and,

WHEREAS, one of the amenities inside the Colfax building is a swimming pool but there had never been a Swim Team as part of the curriculum or extra-curricular activities. In 2016, **Dominic Woods** joined the faculty as a Social Studies teacher, and having been a high school swimmer at Brashear High School, he committed to build a Swim Team, plan practices at the Colfax Pool and then compete against other middle school squads in the city.
