Resolution vacating a portion of Gosser Street between Conniston Avenue and Vernita Street in the 18th Ward, 4th Council District of the City of Pittsburgh.

WHEREAS, it appears by the petition and affidavit on file in the Office of the City Clerk that the owners of all the property fronting or abutting on the line of Gosser Street in the 18th Ward, 4th Council District of the City of Pittsburgh, have petitioned the council of the City of Pittsburgh to enact a resolution for the vacation of same, and

WHEREAS, said petition contains inter-alia, an indemnification of the city from any claims and from the payment of any damages whatsoever resulting to any properties owned by the petitioners or by and persons whatsoever, abutting or non-abutting, for or by reason of said vacation; therefore

Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Pittsburgh as follows:

Section 1. That vacating a portion of Gosser Street, 50 feet wide between Conniston Avenue and Vernita Street, located adjacent to Lot and Blocks 34-S - 328, 330, 260 and 275 and Lots 193, 194, 237, and 238 in the Frank I. Gosser, Bandi Farm Plan, Recorded October 8, 1901, Volume 19, Pages 90-91, Ridgeview, in the 18th Ward, 4th Council District of the City of Pittsburgh as described above shall be and the same is hereby vacated.
