Ryan was an athletic, dynamic and dedicated teenager who played ice hockey for the Arctic Foxes Hockey Association for 8 years. He also played football, track and field and excelled at snowboarding at Seven Springs and in the Colorado Rocky Mountains; and,

WHEREAS, in order to preserve his memory, **The Heitz 61 Memorial Foundation** was created to help young people like Ryan achieve their dreams of sports and scholarship while forever remembering Ryan's indomitable strength and spirit ; and,

WHEREAS, The Heitz 61 Memorial Foundation will host is first fundraiser with **The Heitz of Heaven Hockey Tournament** on September 6-8, 2013 and **The Heitz of Heaven 5K Run/Walk** on September 7, 2013.
