WHEREAS, Matthew Falcone has nominated The Hanauer-Rosenberg House, located at 417 Lockhart Street (8 -D-149) for designation as a Historic Structure; and

WHEREAS, the Historic Review Commission has held a public hearing to gather testimony from the property owner and other interested parties concerning the appropriateness of this designation; and

WHEREAS, the Historic Review Commission has voted to recommend that City Council designate The Hanauer-Rosenberg House, located at 417 Lockhart Street (8-D-149) as a Historic Structure; and

Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Pittsburgh as follows:
