Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Pittsburgh as follows:

Section 1. Pursuant to Chapter 218 of the City Code, regarding capital projects that have been inactive for over three years, Resolution No. 948, effective January 1, 2004, as amended, which presently reads as per **Current Budget Amount**, is hereby amended to read as per **Revised Budget Amount**.

Section 2. The Department Directors and the City Controller are hereby authorized and directed to release

all contracts, encumbrances and pre-encumbrances for the above projects.
