The names listed in this ordinance shall be made official in accordance with the Pittsburgh Code, Title Four, Public Places and Property, Chapter 420 Uniform Street Naming and Addressing.

The Council of the City of Pittsburgh hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. That the name of Putnam Street along its entire length from an intersection with Penn Avenue at its northern end, shall be and the same hereby changed to BAKERY SQUARE BOULEVARD, located in the Seventh Ward.
