**WHEREAS,** the Pittsburgh Darfur Emergency Coalition has for years been raising awareness, activism and funds to help bring an end to these horrors; and

**WHEREAS**, eight refugees from the Darfur region, one spouse from Eritrea, and one additional refugee from South Sudan have recently been resettled in Pittsburgh through the auspices of Catholic Charities, and they are:

handing over to members of the U.S. Congressional staff more than 15,000 postcards of support addressed to President Barack Obama, collected by local activists;
