Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Pittsburgh as follows:

Section 1. The Mayor and the Director of the Department of Public Works are hereby authorized to enter into a cooperation agreement or agreements with Urban Redevelopment Authority of Pittsburgh, in form approved by the City Solicitor, pursuant to which URA will transfer up to \$4,500,000 to the City to be used by the City to pay part of the construction costs associated with the East Liberty Infrastructure Project in East Liberty and Shadyside. Section 2. The Mayor and the Director of the Department of Public Works, on behalf of the City of Pittsburgh, are hereby authorized to enter into an agreement or agreements, or use of existing agreements and/or a contract or contracts or use of existing contracts, in form approved by the City Solicitor, for the construction and other costs incurred in accordance with the terms and conditions of the agreement(s) with URA described in Section 1 of this resolution.
