Resolution vacating a portion of McCrory Way between Federal Street and Hazlip Way in the 25th, Ward, 6th Council District of the City of Pittsburgh.

WHEREAS, it appears by the petition and affidavit on file in the Office of the City Clerk that the owners of all the property fronting or abutting on the line of McCrory Way in the 25th Ward, 6th Council District of the City of Pittsburgh, have petitioned the council of the City of Pittsburgh to enact a resolution for the vacation of same, and

WHEREAS, said petition contains inter-alia, an indemnification of the city from any claims and from the payment of any damages whatsoever resulting to any properties owned by the petitioners or by and persons whatsoever, abutting or non-abutting, for or by reason of said vacation.

Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Pittsburgh as follows:

Section 1. That vacating a portion of McCrory Way, between Federal Street and Hazlip Way 12' in width, 96.6 in length, containing 1159.2 square feet of area, as located in the Robert Hezlep Plan of Lots, Plan Book

Volume 1, Page 106 1/8 No structure can be built 3' in from Hazlip Way on the vacated portion of McCory Way (a 3' x 12') for turn-around purposes only in the 25th Ward, 6th Council District of the City of Pittsburgh as described below shall be and the same is hereby vacated.
