WHEREAS, numerous individuals, clans, societies, clubs and fraternal organizations as well as the St. Andrews Society celebrates Scottish culture and traditions; and

WHEREAS, Robert Murdoch, Esq., a respected Pittsburgh attorney and also the proud son and successor of Pittsburgh's Scottish Tenor Tom Murdoch, of Motherwell, Scotland, has been instrumental in Scottish activities and organizations for more than 40 years, advancing awareness of Scottish heritage and contributions, including being a member of Clan Donald, of the Caledonian Foundation of USA, Inc., the Robert Burns Scottish Club of Erie, the St. Andrews Society of Pittsburgh, the Scottish Heritage Society of North Central West Virginia and the Scottish-American Military Society, and the honors of being elected as a Fellow in the

Society of Antiquaries of Scotland, and, of course, acting as (the first) National Chairman of Tartan Day;
