## Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Pittsburgh as follows"

**Section 1.** The Mayor of the City of Pittsburgh and the Director of the Department of Mobility and Infrastructure are authorized to apply for a grant from Southwestern Pennsylvania Commission's Livability through Smart Transportation Program to provide funding for the West End Trolley Trail. The grant proposal includes an ask of \$800,000.00 with a local match of \$325,000.00 to come out of West End Trolley Trail fund (2020 Capital Budget JDE Job number 6059050220) for a total project cost of ONE MILLION ONE HUNDRED TWENTY FIVE THOUSAND (\$1,125,000.00) for this stated purpose.
