Resolution authorizing the Mayor and the Director of the Department of Public Works to enter into a Professional Services Agreement with the Southwestern Pennsylvania Corporation to complete signal retiming along various corridors in the City of Pittsburgh.

**WHEREAS;** Southwestern Pennsylvania Corporation, a metropolitan planning organization, has secured federal monies to reduce congestion by way of signal retiming efforts;

**WHEREAS;** the City now seeks to enter into a professional services Agreement with the Southwestern Pennsylvania Corporation to evaluate and implement new signal timings for four congested corridors in the City of Pittsburgh.

**Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Pittsburgh as follows:**

**Section 1.** The Mayor and the Director of the Department of Public Works are hereby authorized to enter into a Professional Services Agreement with the Southwestern Pennsylvania Corporation to evaluate and implement new signal timings for East Carson Street from the Birmingham Bridge to 10<sup>th</sup> Street, Liberty Avenue from the Bloomfield Bridge to Aspen Street, Liberty Avenue from 16<sup>th</sup> Street to 31<sup>st</sup> Street, and the Boulevard of the Allies from Craft Avenue to Dawson Street.
