WHEREAS, in recognition of National Child Abuse Prevention Month we would like to honor the Child Advocacy Center (CAC) at Children's Hospital of Pittsburgh of UPMC which was established in the year 2000 as a result of the commitment of the Department of Pediatrics and Children's Hospital of Pittsburgh to ensure that some of our most valuable resources receive competent assessment for maltreatment, as well as the need for ongoing services once abuse has been recognized; and,

WHEREAS, National Child Abuse Prevention Month is a time to acknowledge the importance of families and communities working together to prevent child abuse and increase public awareness of the need to ensure safety and welfare of children; and,

WHEREAS, the mission of the **Child Advocacy Center** is to protect children and promote healthy families through excellence in assessment of child maltreatment, medical and social care for vulnerable children, collaboration with child protection agencies and education and research; and,
