**Section 1.** Section 1 of Resolution No. 204, effective April 12, 2000, as amended, which currently reads:

The Mayor and/or the Deputy Mayor, and/or the Director of the Department of General Services, and/or the Director of the Department of Engineering and Construction, and/or the Director of the Department of Public

Works, and/or the Director of the Department of Parks and Recreation and/or the Director of the Department of City Planning are hereby authorized to enter into a contract or contracts, or use existing contracts, and/or Agreement or Agreements or use existing Agreements for various projects in connection with the Neighborhood Needs Program in Council District 7, in an amount not to exceed Nine Hundred Ninety-Five Thousand, Eight Hundred Fourty-Three Dollars (\$995,843.00), chargeable to and payable from the following chartfields.
