**WHEREAS**, founded in Pittsburgh in 2011 by Emily Levenson and Kate Stoltzfus, Propelle is a networking and coaching organization whose mission is “to shine the light on the amazing work women entrepreneurs in the Pittsburgh region are doing, to foster a community of supportive and creative women, and to provide the tools and resources necessary to help women grow and evolve, both personally and professionally”; and,

**WHEREAS**, Propelle’s in-person networking events and online members-only community provide the opportunity for female business owners to connect with other like-minded women, expand their personal and professional networks, and create valuable business partnerships; and,
