Resolution authorizing the Mayor and Director of the Department of Public Safety to receive grant funding from the US Department of Health and Human Services to assist in the City's Emergency Medical Services' efforts to prevent, prepare for, and respond to the coronavirus not to exceed TWO HUNDRED FORTY SIX THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED TWELVE DOLLARS AND FORTY NINE CENTS (\$246,212.49) for this stated purpose.

Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Pittsburgh as follows:

Section 1. The Mayor and the Director of the Department of Public Safety of the City of Pittsburgh are authorized to execute relevant agreement(s) with the US Department of Health and Human Services in order to receive a grant award in the amount of TWO HUNDRED FORTY SIX THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED TWELVE DOLLARS AND FORTY NINE CENTS (\$246,212.49) for the purpose of assisting in the City's Emergency Medical Services' efforts in preventing, preparing for, and responding to the coronavirus. Monies from the grant agreement shall be deposited into the EMS General Fund revenue account 11101.220000,45,45703.
