Resolution amending Resolution 866 of 2010, authorizing the creation of the Emergency Medical Services Hazardous Materials Trust Fund, to rename the fund, and clarify and update its uses.

**Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Pittsburgh as follows:**

**Section 1.** That the City Controller is hereby authorized and directed to create a trust fund entitled "~~Emergency Medical Services~~ **Public Safety** Hazardous Materials Trust Fund" into which shall be deposited funds paid to the City from Allegheny County (LEPC) and/or income generated as a result of direct billing of responsible parties as recoverable for hazardous materials responses, for the purpose of purchase of equipment, supplies, **medical certifications and examinations for Department of Public Safety hazardous materials personnel**, training, and unrecoverable hazardous material cleanup cost.

**Section 2.** The Trust Fund shall be established within the Department of Public Safety, Bureau of ~~Emergency Medical Services~~ **Administration**, set forth in the City of Pittsburgh's annual budget, and may only be expended through the regular contracting process or other expenditures as set forth in the city.

**Section 3.** Any proceeds received by the City from Allegheny County (LEPC) and/or income generated as a result of direct billing of responsible parties as recoverable for hazardous materials responses, shall be transferred to this Trust Fund.
