Resolution authorizing the Mayor and the Director of the Department of Public Works to enter into an Ownership and Maintenance Agreement with the Sports and Exhibition Authority of Pittsburgh and Allegheny County to maintain at the City's sole cost and expense, the completed streets in the Lower Hill Development, in Council District 6 of the City of Pittsburgh.

**Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Pittsburgh as follows:**

**Section 1.** The Mayor and the Director of the Department of Public Works are hereby authorized to enter into an Ownership and Maintenance Agreement with the Sports and Exhibition Authority of Pittsburgh and Allegheny County to maintain the completed streets in the Lower Hill Development, including roadways, sidewalks, street lighting and street trees, in Council District 6 of the City of Pittsburgh. The form and substance of the Ownership and Maintenance Agreement shall be subject to the approval of the City Solicitor.
