**Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Pittsburgh as follows:**

**Section 1.** The Council of the City of Pittsburgh authorizes and directs the City Solicitor to immediately request from the Pittsburgh Intergovernmental Cooperation Authority copies of all consultant reports and staff work related to the Authority's rejection of the Mayor's proposed budget and their recommendations for further reductions in spending.
