Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Pittsburgh as follows:

Section 1. The Mayor and the Director of the Department of Finance, on behalf of the City of Pittsburgh, are hereby authorized to enter into negotiations with ~~various persons and/or entities~~ **the Pittsburgh Parking Authority** for the ~~sole~~ purpose of ~~leasing~~ **transferring** parking assets owned or operated by the City and/or the ~~to the~~ Public Parking Authority of Pittsburgh in exchange for substantial up-front consideration to the City and ~~the Authority~~. The terms and conditions of any such ~~lease~~ **agreement** and related documents must **explicitly forbid any future sale, lease or transfer of City Parking facilities to any other entity without prior approval from City Council and** must be submitted to and approved by Council.

~~Finally, that any Ordinance or Resolution or part thereof conflicting with the provisions of this Resolution, is hereby repealed so far as the same affects this Resolution.~~
