Resolution providing for an Agreement or Agreements, or the use of existing Agreements for the Vacant Lot Cleanup and Maintenance Program, January 1, 2003 and providing for the payment of (\$200,000.00) Dollars, the cost thereof.

Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Pittsburgh as follows:

Section 1. The Mayor and the Director of the Department of Public Works, on behalf of the City of Pittsburgh, are hereby authorized to advertise for proposals and to award and enter into an Agreement or Agreements, or the use of existing Agreements in a form approved by City Solicitor, for professional services for the administration and marketing City Neighborhoods and lot clean up services in relation to educating the public on litter, at a cost not to exceed Two Hundred Thousand (\$200,000.00) Dollars, chargeable to and payable from Account 527900, Fund 1000, Org. 430000, Sub-Class 150, Budget Year 2003, Property Management, Department of Public Works.
