Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Pittsburgh as follows:

Section 1. The Mayor and the Director of the Office of Management & Budget, on behalf of the City of Pittsburgh, are hereby authorized to enter into an extension of the current contract (#50116) with Allied Communications for Fleet GPS Tracking Services for eight (8) months. The total cost for said extension shall not exceed Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000), chargeable to and payable from the following accounts:
