Resolution amending Resolution No. 387 of 2020, which authorized the City of Pittsburgh to enter into an amended Professional Services Agreement(s) with Corporate Cost Control for third party administration of the City of Pittsburgh’s liabilities under the Pennsylvania Unemployment Compensation Act for 4 additional years of services, by extending this contract for an additional four years and authorizing spend for these additional years.

Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Pittsburgh as follows:

Resolution No. 387 of 2020, entitled “Resolution amending Resolution No. 484 of 2016, which authorized the City of Pittsburgh to enter into a Professional Services Agreement(s) with Corporate Cost Control for third party administration of the City of Pittsburgh’s liabilities under the Pennsylvania Unemployment Compensation Act by, increasing the authorized spend by \$10,400 for 2 additional years of services.” is hereby amended as follows:

Section 1. The Mayor and the Director of Department of Human Resources and Civil Service, on behalf of the City of Pittsburgh, are hereby authorized to enter into Professional Services Agreement(s) and/or Contracts with Corporate Cost Control for third party administration of the City of Pittsburgh's liabilities under the Pennsylvania Unemployment Compensation Act, in a form approved by the City Solicitor. The total amount shall not exceed ~~Thirty One Thousand Two Hundred Dollars~~ **Fifty Two Thousand Dollars (\$52,000.00)** chargeable to and payable from the following account lines:
