Resolution providing for a Contract or Agreement or the use of existing Contracts or Agreements to purchase medical equipment for the Bureau of Emergency Medical Services, at a cost not to exceed Fifty-Six Thousand Dollars (\$56,000.00).

Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Pittsburgh as follows:

Section 1. The Director of the Department of General Services or the Director of the Department of Public Safety on behalf of the City of Pittsburgh, is hereby authorized to enter into a Contract or Contracts or Agreement or Agreements or the use of existing Contracts or Agreements in a form approved by the City Solicitor to purchase medical equipment for the Bureau of Emergency Medical Services. Total cost shall not exceed Fifty-Six Thousand (\$56,000.00) chargeable to and payable from Organization Code 220000, Fund 1000, Account 540100, Sub-Class 120, Budget Year 2002, Equipment, Bureau of Emergency Medical Services, Department of Public Safety.
