Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Pittsburgh as follows:

Section 1. The Mayor and the Director of the Department of Mobility and Infrastructure, on behalf of the City of Pittsburgh, are hereby authorized to execute relevant agreements with PennDot allowing for reimbursement of the local costs associated with the SR0885 (Boulevard of the Allies) ADA Ramps being constructed and inspected by PennDOT

Section 2.

The Mayor and the Director of the Department of Mobility and Infrastructure, on behalf of the City of Pittsburgh, are hereby authorized to execute payments to PennDOT for local reimbursement to PenDOT for costs associated with the SR0885 (Boulevard of the Allies) ADA Ramps construction and upgraded black traffic

signal poles installation, at a cost estimated to be \$77,707.50.
