Ordinance supplementing the Pittsburgh Code, Title Nine, Zoning; Chapter 911, Primary Uses, Section 911.02 Use Table, by amending existing language in the definition of Custodial Care Facility.

**The Council of the City of Pittsburgh hereby enacts as follows:**

**Section 1.** The Pittsburgh Code, Title Nine, Zoning; Chapter 911, Primary Uses, Section 911.02 Use Table, is hereby amended as follows:

**911.02. Use Table.**

**Custodial Care Facility** is a facility providing custodial care and treatment in a protective [**living**] environment for persons residing **or attending** by court placement, [**including, without limitation,**] post-correctional facilities, juvenile detention facilities, [**and**] temporary detention facilities, **and halfway**

**houses.** This includes halfway houses and similar facilities for people on probation or parole **[who have been placed there as a condition of a judicial order,] and halfway houses for people leaving a correctional facility or placed there as a form of alternative sentencing.**
