**Title:** Resolution further amending and supplementing Resolution No. 257, effective April 26, 2000, as amended, entitled "Providing for an Agreement or Agreements, or use of existing Agreements and/or a Contract or Contracts, or use of existing Contracts, and for the purchase of materials, supplies, equipment, and/or services for various projects in connection with the Mayor's citywide Neighborhood Needs Program; and providing for the payment of the costs thereof," by reducing the line item "In-line/Skateboard Parks (2)" by \$10,000, and adding the same amount to a new line item "Lawrenceville Citizens Council". Total cost of all projects is not to exceed \$973,884.

Resolution further amending and supplementing Resolution No. 257, effective April 26, 2000, as amended, entitled "Providing for an Agreement or Agreements, or use of existing Agreements and/or a Contract or Contracts, or use of existing Contracts, and for the purchase of materials, supplies, equipment, and/or services for various projects in connection with the Mayor's citywide Neighborhood Needs Program; and providing for the payment of the costs thereof," by reducing the line item "In-line/Skateboard Parks (2)" by \$10,000, and adding the same amount to a new line item "Lawrenceville Citizens Council". Total cost of all projects is not to exceed \$973,884.

**Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Pittsburgh as follows:**

**Section 1.** Section 1 of Resolution No. 257, effective April 26, 2000, as amended, which currently reads as follows:

The Mayor and/or the Deputy Mayor, and/or the Director of the Department of General Services, and/or the Director of the Department of Engineering and Construction, and/or the Director of the Department of Public Works, and/or the Director of the Department of Parks and Recreation and/or the Director of the Department of

City Planning are hereby authorized to enter into a contract or contracts, or use existing contracts, and/or Agreement or Agreements or use existing Agreements for various projects in connection with the Mayor's citywide Neighborhood Needs Program, in an amount not to exceed Nine Hundred Seventy-Three Thousand, Eight Hundred Eighty-Four Dollars (\$973,884.00), chargeable to and payable from the following chartfields.
