**WHEREAS**, Wilbert Darling is a distinguished member of the United States' Greatest Generation for his service in WWII; and,

**WHEREAS**, Mr. Darling graduated from the University of Pittsburgh as a Pharmacist in 1943. Soon after graduation, he was commissioned as an Ensign in the U.S. Navy assigned to the Pacific Fleet; and,
