Resolution further amending Resolution No. 43, effective February 15, 2000, as amended by Resolution No. 491, effective July 20, 2001, entitled "Providing for a Contract or Contracts or for the use of existing Contracts, providing for an Agreement or Agreements or for the use of existing Agreements, and providing for the purchase of materials and supplies in connection with the Renovation of Recreation Centers and Senior Citizen Centers; and further providing for the payment of the costs thereof," by increasing the total project allocation by \$30,000 from \$720,000 to \$750,000.

Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Pittsburgh as follows:

Section 1. Section 1 of Resolution No. 43, effective February 15, 2000, as amended by Resolution No. 491, effective July 20, 2001, which presently reads as follows:
