Resolution amending Resolution No. 646 of 2014 authorizing the Mayor and the City Solicitor to enter into a professional services agreement or agreements with Pepper Hamilton, LLP, for professional consulting and legal services in relation to *United States ex. rel Freedom Unlimited, Inc., et al. v. City of Pittsburgh, et al.*, to utilize Pepper Hamilton LLP’s professional and special expertise in housing and the False Claims Act and related matters by adding an additional sum of THREE HUNDRED FORTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$340,000).

**Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Pittsburgh as follows:**

**Section 1.** Resolution No. 646 of 2014, effective October 14, 2014, is hereby amended to authorize the Mayor and the City Solicitor, on behalf of the City of Pittsburgh, to enter into a professional services agreement or agreements with Pepper Hamilton, LLP, for consulting services. That agreement(s) will be in a form approved by the City Solicitor and will contain those terms and conditions as the City Solicitor may require. An additional sum of THREE HUNDRED FORTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$340,000), chargeable to and payable from Account 11101.53.53517.108000.201[4]5.
